## Employment & Settlement Support

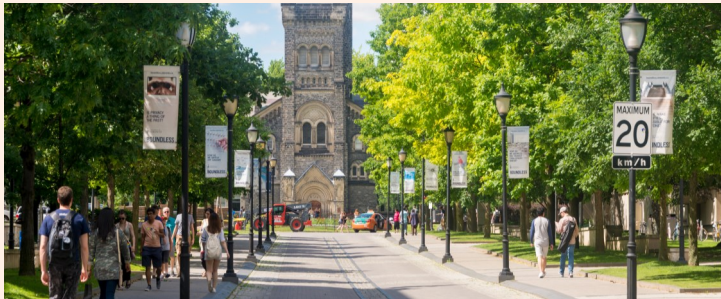
**YMCA of Southwestern Ontario** provides a wide range of information on employment and volunteer opportunities that best suit your needs.
