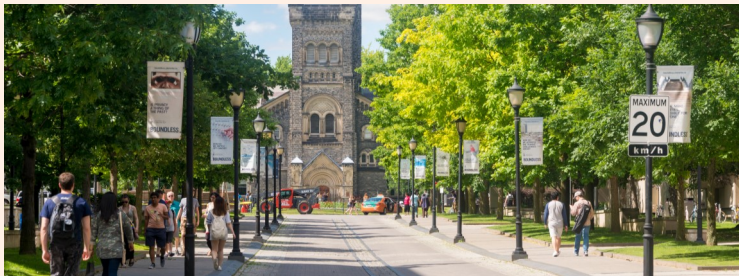
Employment & Settlement Support
